**Keynote Speaker**  
**Rev. Dr. Bernard Lafayette**



Rev. Dr. Bernard Lafayette, an ordained minister, is a longtime civil rights activist, organizer, and an authority on nonviolent social change. He co-founded the Student Nonviolent Coordinating Committee (SNCC) in 1960, and he was a core leader of the civil rights movement in Nashville, TN, in 1960 and in Selma, AL, in 1965. He directed the Alabama Voter Registration Project in 1962, and he was appointed by Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. to be national program administrator for the Southern Christian Leadership Conference and national coordinator of the 1968 Poor People's Campaign. Dr. Lafayette was with Dr. King on that fateful day in Memphis when King was assassinated. Rev. Dr. Lafayette is also a Distinguished Senior Scholar-in-Residence in the Graduate Division of Religion and Candler School of Theology at Emory University.
